Why does my friend want to pass this around and call her a "ho?" I can't believe her. What is my friend thinking? Not only is it wrong, but she could get in trouble for this. Should I say something to her?... If I forward this to anyone else, I might get in trouble.... Do I have a responsibility to her to say something?.... If I do, won't she be mad at me?...

What should I do in this situation?

OPTIONS

- Do nothing. It's none of my business.
- 2 Tell my friend to delete the picture immediately. Try to convince her that it's wrong and disrespectful for her to be circulating it.
- **3** Warn her that it might even be against the law.
- Discreetly tell the girl in the photo directly or through a friend of hers that her picture is circulating, and let her deal with it.

- Identify another friend of ours who might agree with me and together figure out what to do.
- Ask my parent, a teacher or a coach I trust, or another adult whose opinion I value to get advice on what to do.
